All Ticket Sales are Through the Pioneer Box Office: All tickets are \$18. Volunteer's Needed: Volunteer chaperones are needed for all classes backstage. We would like to have two or more for our 3-6 age groups and if possible, one or more for older classes. To volunteer, please email us at artinmotionreno@att.net or sign up by calling the studio at 775-626-6235. Volunteers need to be available the whole day for both Dress Rehearsal and show. Volunteers will be able to view the show from the front of the stage at Dress Rehearsal and from the side of the stage at show. We need volunteers to stay with their class throughout. More information will be given to you when you volunteer. Please provide us with an email and phone number when signing up.

Mandatory Dress Rehearsal is prior to the Show, June 17 from 11 a.m-2 p.m. *Dancers will be dropped off at the backstage door and unless you are a volunteer, you will not be able to go backstage. Except for the starred classes below, all dancers will attend their Dress Rehearsal on stage. Dancers will be dropped off at the backstage entrance behind the theater. Parents will not be allowed to go with them backstage, only volunteer chaperones. This is a mandatory rehearsal. If your dancer does not attend the Dress Rehearsal, they will not be able to participate in the show! (Any conflicts or pre-scheduled attendance must have been approved at time of signing the commitment costume form.)*

All performers should be in full costume and make up for both Dress Rehearsal and show. Dress Rehearsal is like a pre-show. Each class will perform their dance in show order and, if necessary, stop and repeat the dance so that the lighting, music and dancing all run smoothly.

First Half Dancers will Have a Break Between Dress Rehearsal and Show: First Half Dancers should have a bit of a break between the Dress Rehearsal and show call time. Performance Group dancers may not. If you would like to pick up your dancer in-between rehearsal and show, please contact the stage volunteer chaperone to meet your dancer **at the backstage entrance**, the same spot you drop off your dancer. Pick up time depends on availability. **The Pioneer does not want any dancers running around at all.** All Performance Group dancers should plan to remain backstage. Any dancer who does not get picked up by a parent will have to remain backstage with their volunteer until show. So please prepare your dancer with snacks, water, and if needed a big T-shirt to cover their costume from getting dirty or stained etc...

After Dress Rehearsal Dancers are Required to be Backstage at 2 p.m. SHOWTIME CALL is VITAL! Performers' are due backstage by 2 p.m. and will enter the same way, at the back of the theater stage door entrance. Show will start at 3 p.m.

Stage Make-up: Make-up should be applied generously. A light blush on the eyes and cheeks, mascara, and lipstick is required. Dancers must wear makeup so the stage lights do not wash them out. (Bring a cosmetic bag to reapply if needed.) Please make sure that your dancer's hair accessories are secured with hair pins and that your dancer's hair is styled as required by their instructor. All performance group will wear their hair half up and half down except for ballet dancers that require a bun. ***Just a reminder that unless specified, no underwear is to be worn under costumes that have tights or a leotard.***

Performer's Accessories and Props It is the responsibility of the parent to make sure that their dancer has all parts of his/her costume, i.e. hair accessories, fans, gloves, hats or any other props. If the dance has a prop that is going to be brought by their instructor, like a bench or fans, they will be on stage left for pickup prior to going on stage.

Pick Up of Your Star Dancer: **For your dancer's safety, the Pioneer does not want parents backstage before, during or after the show unless they are our staff or volunteer chaperones.** Parents must check out their dancer with the assigned chaperone in the Ex-Hall. The entrance to the Ex-Hall is in the lobby and on the left hand side by the bathrooms. PG Dancers must also meet at this location unless they are over the age of 12. Dancers over the age of 12 can check themselves out and meet parents upstairs outside. Parents can enter the Ex-Hall from the lobby by the bathrooms, go in to sign out your child and pick them up, and then exit the back way, down the back of house hall to the left to get back to the lobby. That way it doesn't create a huge traffic jam at the entrance doors. Everyone should remember to be courteous and move somewhat quickly so that all 150 dancers can be picked up. If you're celebrating with family, we recommend one parent pick up the dancer and everyone meet upstairs outside.
