



# Recital Package 2011

Hello parents of performing students! This is an exciting time for you and your dancer. Art In Motion Reno, LLC has enclosed some very important information with this package to help you get the best out of this year's performance "Pop, Rock, Shake and Shine" at Damonte Ranch Theater June 11 at 4 and 5:30 p.m.

**DVD Order Form** is enclosed. There is an "Early Bird Special" on the video saving you money if purchased before May 31. Forms can be given to your instructor.

**Tickets** Extra \$5 tickets are available and can be purchased from your instructor. **There is a limit of four extra tickets per family.** These do run out fast so we do encourage that you possibly volunteer. Volunteers do not need a ticket to get in but must be on the volunteer list.

**To Volunteer** Contact Monique Bowman at [Art\\_In\\_Motion@charter.net](mailto:Art_In_Motion@charter.net) or sign up with your instructor. Volunteers are needed to stay with the performing dancers during Dress Rehearsal and Show. Volunteers will be able to view the show from the front of the stage at Dress Rehearsal and from the side of the stage at show. More information will be given to you when you volunteer.

**Dress Rehearsal is prior to the Show, Friday, June 10 from 5:30-8:30 p.m.** This is a mandatory rehearsal and parents can attend. If your dancer is not in attendance, they will not perform in the show. Performer's for the 4 p.m. show need to be at the theater at 5:30 p.m. Performer's for the 5:30 p.m. show need to be at the theater at 7 p.m. All performers will need to wear their costume and make-up for both dress rehearsal and show. Dress rehearsal is like a pre-show. Each dance will performed their dance in show order and, if necessary, stop and repeat the dance so that the lighting, music and dancing all run smoothly. Dancers will remain in the theater during dress rehearsal so they will be able to watch the show during this time. All dancers will be grouped together with their class for both dress and show.

**Bow** This is the first time all dancers will be all together for their bow which will be practiced at the end of dress rehearsal and occur at the end of their show. The bow will have the students go on stage from tallest to smallest. If your dancer is in more than one class, they will perform bow in their last costume that they danced in.

**Stage Makeup** Makeup should be applied generously. A light blush on the eyes and cheeks, mascara, and red lipstick. Dancers must wear makeup so the stage lights do not wash them out. (Bring a cosmetic bag to reapply if needed.) Please make sure that your dancer's hair is secure with hairspray and or hair pins. Check with your instructor for hair style requirements. Please talk with them prior to dress rehearsal so that the dancer has the appropriate hair-style. *Just a reminder that unless specified, no underwear is to be worn under costumes that have tights or a leotard.*

**Performer's Accessories and Props** It is the responsibility of the parent to make sure that their child has all parts of his/her costume, i.e. hair accessories, fans, gloves, hats or any other props. If the dance has a prop that is going to be brought by their instructor, like the chairs, they will be on the side of the stage for pickup.

**SHOWTIME is VITAL.** Since there is a little break between both shows, all dancers and backstage helpers should be back at the dancer's area (hallway) a half hour before their show time. Invited guests can enter the theater at 15 minutes before the performance. Seating is first come first served.

***Dancers who perform in*** the second dance, i.e.; Saturday HH: Ice Cream Paint Job for the 4 p.m. show need to be backstage ready to start at 4 p.m. and Friday Street HH: OMG"-Usher, "Fancy"-Drake, and "Whip My Hair need to be backstage and ready to start at the 5:30 p.m. show. All dancers are in the Bow and will need to be lined up with their groups and be ready to perform before the last dance, *Party Rock Anthem*. After the Show is over, you then can join your dancer for accolades!

### **Directions to Damonte Ranch High School Theater**

Go South on 395 towards Reno

Take the Damonte Ranch Parkway Exit 59

Turn Left onto Damonte Ranch Parkway

Turn Left onto Steamboat Parkway (near CVS Pharmacy)

Turn Right onto Veterans Parkway

Turn Left onto Rio Wrangler Parkway (housing development)

End 10500 Rio Wrangler Parkway

Entrance to theater is directly in front of the school

### **Inside the Building**

Dancers will be on the left side of the theater hallway before the main entrance to the theater.

Please do not bring food or drinks into the theater. You can give your dancer bottled water that they can bring with them in the hallway.

Public bathrooms are on the left corner of 1st and the main hallway by the library.
